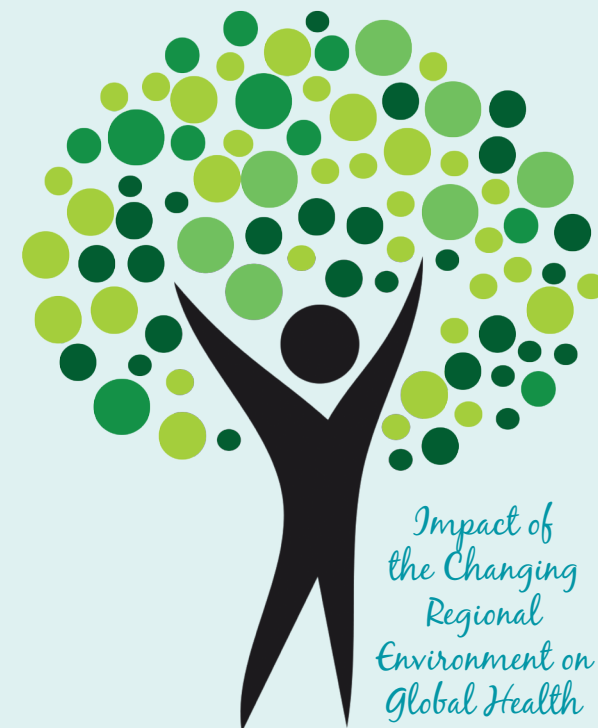

GUIDELINES FOR THE POSTER EXHIBIT

Content

The poster should include the following identifying information:

- » Name or title of research or project
- » Name of author(s)
- » Complete name and address of affiliation/institution
- » Telephone or contact numbers or email

It should contain the following sections:

- » Introduction
- » Objectives
- » Methodology
- » Results and Discussion
- » Conclusion

Format

Poster material should be legible from a distance of 2 meters and should be printed in a 3 ft width by 5 ft height tarpaulin with ring holes on all corners.

The title should be the same as the title submitted with the abstract and appear in boldface at the top.
